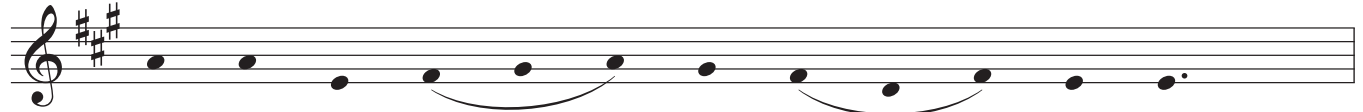


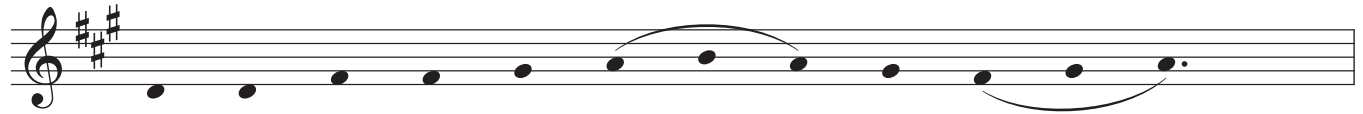

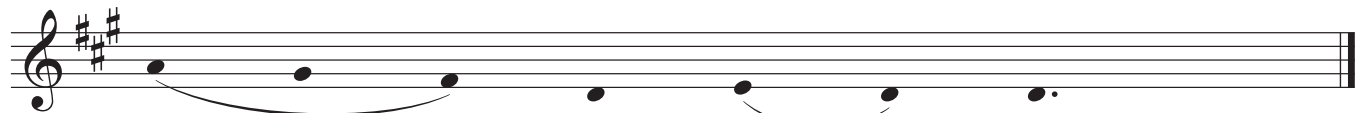
O Thou that bring - est light from light,
